PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Promote sportsmanship within their groups, among teams within Van Isle Wave Program and opponents;
- Choose fair play under any circumstances;
- Understand that enjoyment comes prior to winning at all costs;
- Be courteous with athletes from other teams, teammates, coaches, officials, parents and others involved in the soccer environment;
- Remember that, as a member, you represent the Van Isle Wave Program and must conduct yourself accordingly;
- Understand that hard work can make you successful, but teamwork will make you be remembered;
- Aim to attend all practices and games on time;
- Respect coaches and team manager's authority;
- Refrain from the use of inappropriate language, whomever you are speaking with;
- The use of drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited when representing the Van Isle Wave Program (not limited to match days or practice sessions).
- Players who don't follow those guidelines are subject to probation, which can lead to further disciplinary actions.
